Foundation and Basic Practitioners Courses

Foundation 6 hours

Aimed at: Low Risk Service Settings & Individuals (eg Mainstream Secondary and Primary Schools)

This Course Covers:

- Background, values, rationale and principles that underpin Team-Teach.
- Policy, practice, recording, reporting, legal considerations and Circular Guide-lines.
- Understanding Aggression and Conflict.
- Staff awareness and self-control whilst managing disruptive and challenging behaviour.
- Behavioural management strategies and techniques that minimise risk.
- Protective and personal safety.
- Positive physical interventions: assisting, guiding, holding.
- Process of learning, support, reflection and repair for all involved.

Basic 12 hours

Aimed at: Medium to Elevated Risk Service Settings & Individuals (eg "special needs"/ schools / homes / social care / hospitals)

This Course Covers:

- Issues and strategies for Transport situations.

Additional Advanced Skills. Advanced tutors to select the skills required above by their staff and allocate time according to risk assessment in their service setting. A minimum of 6 hours (1 day)

Intermediate and Advanced Tutor Courses

Intermediate Tutor Course

Five Day Basic Tutor Course applicants for this course must first of all have successfully completed a basic 12 hour course

Curriculum to provide Skills to teach the Foundation 6 hour and 12 hour Basic Practitioner Courses. Potential Basic Tutors must have evidence of having competed a Basic Practitioner 12 hour course plus a 1 day first Aid Qualification (required from 02).

Advanced Tutor Course

Four Day Advanced Skills Tutor Course

Curriculum to provide Skills to teach Advanced Practitioner Courses. Potential advanced tutors must have competed a Intermediate Tutor's Course plus an Advanced Practitioner Course (requirement from 2004) and a 1 day first aid Emergency at Work qualification.
